

Tip—Follow the “5 and 10 Rule” for projecting text on-screen: Limit the text on each slide to five or six lines and what most people can read in ten or twelve seconds. Make sure the text is large enough: at least 48 points for titles, 36 points for primary body text, and 28 points for Scripture references.
